the Halichondridæ, with long supporting fibrous beards.

From its appearance when brought up *Holtenia* evidently lives buried in the mud to its upper fringe of spicules. When freshly dredged, it is loaded with




Fig. 7.—Tisiphonia agariciformis, WYVILLE THOMSON. Natural size. (No. 12.)

pale grey semi-fluid sarcode, full of Globigerinæ, Triloculinæ, and other rhizopods, and covered in our northern localities with the little ophiurid Amphiura abyssicola, Sars, and the exquisitely delicate trans-
