of its cup, certainly presents a curious resemblance to the Cambrian Dictyonema. This resemblance must, however, be only superficial, for Dictyonema passes, with many points of accordance equally remarkable, into the graptolites, which we can scarcely doubt must be referred to a very different group.




Fig. 31.—Salenia varispina, A. Ag. Four times the natural size. (No. 6.)
