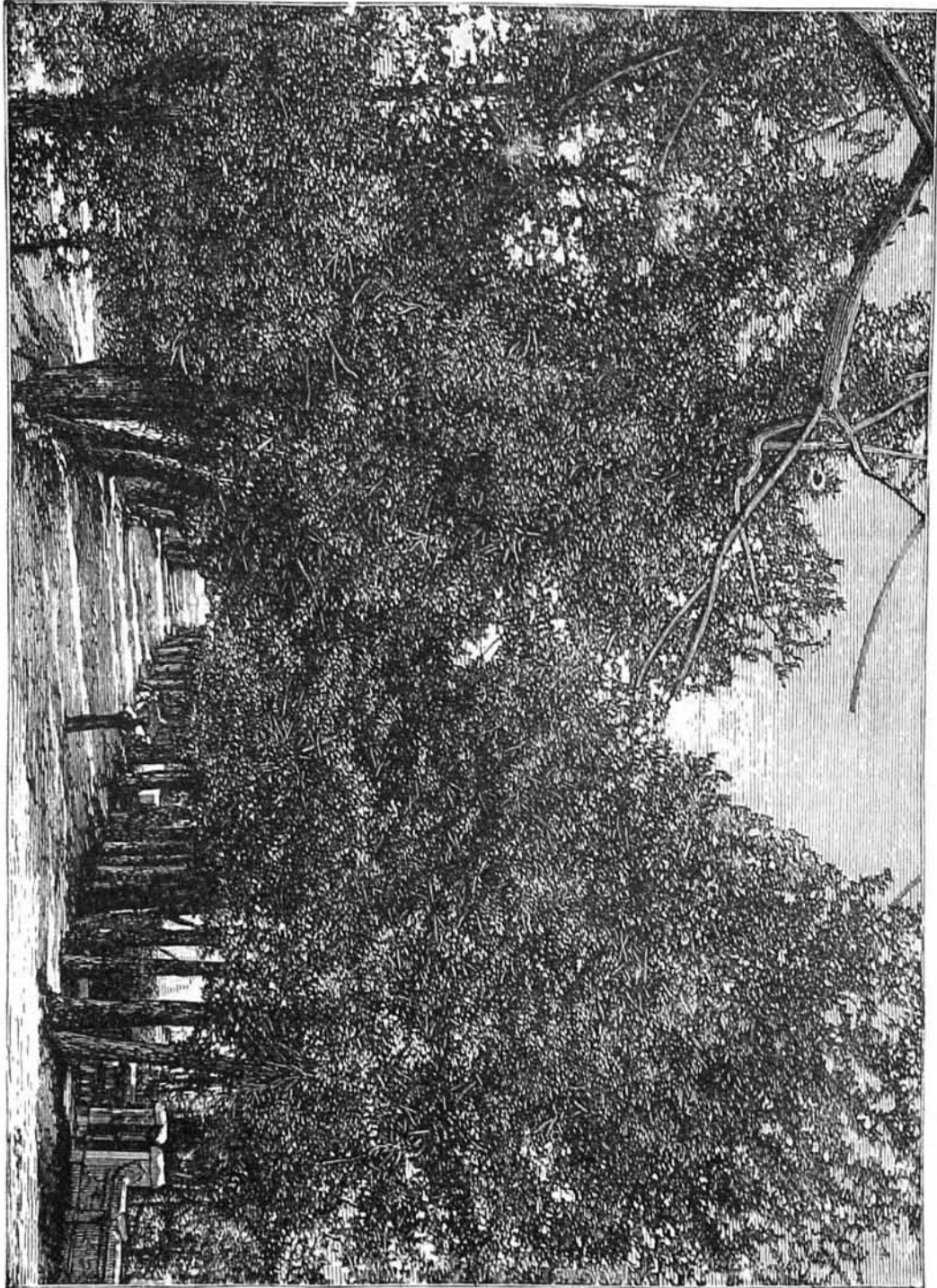


FIG. 85.—Cedar Avenue, Hamilton, Bermudas. (From a photograph.)
