have disappeared from the gardens. Fruit is by no means abundant. The smaller English fruits—gooseberry, raspberry,




Fig. 87.—Papaw-trees (Carica papaya) in the Garden at Clarence Hill. (From a photograph.) currant, etc.—run to wood, and do not bear. Strawberries fruit fairly. Bananas are very generally cultivated, and are good, al-
