
of lava and scoriæ and a congregation of small volcanic cones, wonderfully sharp and perfect, and with all the appearance of being comparatively recent. It is across this neck that the road



passes to Furnas, and as it wound among the wooded dells between the cones we had a splendid view of the northern coast, with its long line of headlands—lava flows separated by deep bays radiantly blue and white under the sun and wind, and pass-
