Station CCCXVIII., February 11th, 1876.—Lat.  $42^{\circ} 32'$  S., Long.  $56^{\circ} 27'$  W. Depth, 2040 fathoms. Bottom temperature,  $0^{\circ} 3$  C. Gray mud.

Station CCCXIX., February 12th, 1876.—Lat.  $41^{\circ} 54'$  S., Long.  $54^{\circ} 48'$  W. Depth, 2425 fathoms. Bottom temperature,  $0^{\circ} 4$  C. Gray mud.
