arenaceous forms, such as Reophax, Hyperammina, Haplophragmium, had always a dark brown-coloured pigment, similar to the phæodium of the Phæodaria.




Fig. 311.—Orbulina universa (d'Orbigny), from the surface.

The sarcode of Biloculina, Truncatulina, and Discorbina was yellowish in colour, and resembled that of the pelagic species.
