- Fig. 1. Foot of *Nephthys trissophyllus*, from Kerguelen. A few parasitic Nematoids are attached to the branchia, × about 8.
- Fig. 2. Foot of *Nephthys malmgreni* (?), (from the anterior third), × about 40.
- Fig. 3. Foot of *Nephthys phyllobranchia*, 1240 fathoms, × 55.
- Fig. 4. Foot of *Nephthys trissophyllus*, from the front. The ventral cirrus is viewed nearly on edge. It is lanceolate, × about 8.
- Fig. 5. Foot of *Nephthys dibranchis*. The papilla at the base of the upper branchia is hidden, and the foot is somewhat flattened from softening, × about 20.
