

This is a most exceptional and peculiar little species, quite unlike any other.

In Professor Seguenza's figure the little rounded tubercles which stud the glossy surface of the shell are arranged in regular horizontal and less regular vertical rows; but in all the specimens I have seen, kindly sent me by Professor Seguenza, they arrange themselves transversely. In the Challenger specimen these tubercles are much more numerous and smaller, and are horizontally oblong, not round as in the fossil shell. Professor Seguenza (*loc. cit.*) refers to "due solchette laterali, superficiali poco distinti," which run downwards and forwards from the top on the line of attachment of the internal septum. Of these there is barely a trace in the Challenger specimen.
