*Habitat*.—Indian Ocean, Philippines (Kobelt).

This species, though often put (as, for instance, by Adams, Genera, vol. i. p. 83, and Tryon, *loc. cit.*) under *Hemifusus* (= *Cochlidium*), has the true operculum as well as the general form of a *Fusus*.
