Celebes Sea, lat. 6° 54' 0" N., long. 122° 18' 0" E., in 10 fathoms (Station 212). An adult female, bearing ova.

The specimen is imperfect, having lost two of the legs, but one of these, the first of the ambulatory legs on the right hand side, is replaced by a new and imperfectly developed limb, measuring only 5 lines (10.5 mm.).
