### *Alpheus biunguiculatus* (p. 562).

- „ 4. Lateral view; enlarged three times.
- „ 4o. Fifth pereiopod; terminal joints.

### *Betæus malleodigitus* (p. 565).

- „ 5. Lateral view; enlarged three times.
- „ 5c. Cephalon, frontal region.
- „ 5c. Second antennæ; scaphocerite.
- „ 5k. First pereiopod; larger chela.

- „ 5p. First pleopod, with parasites attached to peduncle; stylamblys detached and enlarged.
