- Fig. 3. Transverse section of the tube-wall (combination figure) ;  $\times 100$ .
- Fig. 4. Uncinatum with few bent spines ;  $\times 450$ .
- Figs. 5, 9. Dermal clavulæ with club-shaped head, hemispherically arched umbel and tuberculate stalk ;  $\times 450$ .
- Fig. 6. Dermal pentact with somewhat inwardly bent tangential rays, tuberculate on the outer side ;  $\times 100$ .
- Fig. 7. Oxyhexaster with long principal, and small, divergent, terminal rays ;  $\times 450$ .
- Figs. 8, 10. Gastral clavulæ with anchor-like six-spined head, and without roughness on the main part of the stalk ;  $\times 450$ .
