ANIMALS FROM
TRAWL AND
DREDGE.

The following species are recorded in the Zoological Reports from the trawl and dredge at this Station :—

TETRACTINELLIDA (Sollas, Zool. pt. 63).

Myriastria clavosa, Ridley, var. *quadrata*, nov. One specimen; the species obtained also at Stations 186 and 208.

ALCYONARIA (Wright and Studer, Zool. pt. 64).

Spongodes florida (Esper). One specimen; obtained at no other locality by the Challenger. Recorded from Australia and Philippines.

„ *anguina*, n.sp. One specimen; obtained at no other locality.

„ *bicolor*, n.sp. One young specimen; obtained also in Torres Strait.

PENNATULIDA (Kölliker, Zool. pt. 2).

Pteroeides esperi, Herklots. Several specimens; obtained at no other locality by the Challenger. Recorded from Philippines.

Haliscyprum gustavianum, Herklots, var. *parvifolia*, Kölliker. Four specimens; obtained at no other locality by the Challenger.

Scytalium sarsi, Herklots. Five specimens; obtained at no other locality by the Challenger. Original locality unknown.

CORALS (Moseley, Zool. pt. 7).

Heterocyathus philippinensis, Semper. Numerous specimens; obtained at no other locality by the Challenger.

Heteropsammia michelini, M.-Edwards and Haime. Numerous specimens; obtained at no other locality by the Challenger.

CRINOIDEA (Carpenter, Zool. pt. 60).

Antedon milberti (Müller). Two specimens; obtained also at Station 203.

„ *clemens*, n.sp. One specimen; obtained at no other locality.

„ *anceps*, n.sp. Three specimens; obtained at no other locality.

„ *quinduplicava*, n.sp. One specimen and fragment; obtained at no other locality.
