STATION 212.

Excluding Protozoa, over 250 specimens of invertebrates and fishes were obtained at this Station, belonging to about 84 species, of which 22 are new to science, including representatives of 2 new genera; 17 of the new species were not obtained elsewhere.

Willemoes-Suhm writes: "Five little Stylifers were taken on the skin of a Holothurian; a Porcellana seemed to live between the arms of a Virgularian; a shell was found on the branches of a Plumularian, the stem of which was occupied by a Polyzoon; and a Sipunculid inhabited holes bored into the bases of the Corals Heterocyathus and Heteropsammia. There were very few Sponges. The long blue compound Ascidians, belonging to the genus Chondrostachys, were interesting, and there were besides specimens belonging to the Botryllidæ. The Crustacea were represented by a crab, previously taken near Tongatabu, Pagurus, Porcellana, and Remipes."

ORGANISMS FROM SURFACE-NETS. Surface Organisms.—The following are recorded in the note-books from the surface :— Sagitta, larvæ of worms and Cirripeds in abundance, along with Copepods and other things.

AT THE PHILIPPINES.

The expedition visited the Philippine Islands in October and November 1874, and again, after returning from Hong Kong, in January and February 1875 (for description of the islands see Narr. Chall. Exp., vol. i. pp. 648-666). The following species are recorded in the Zoological Reports as having been obtained in shallow water and on shore during the stay in the vicinity of the Philippine Islands, principally at Samboangan and Zebu:—

ANIMALS FROM PHILIPPINES. Tetractinellida (Sollas, Zool. pt. 63).

Craniella simillima (Bowerbank), var. (Samboangan); obtained also at Stations 163B and 186.

Tethya seychellensis (Wright). One specimen (Samboangan); obtained also at Station 186.

ALCYONARIA (Wright and Studer, Zool. pt. 64).

Melitodes philippinensis, n.sp. Several specimens (Samboangan reefs); obtained at no other locality.

" sinuata, n.sp. One specimen (Samboangan reefs); obtained at no other locality.

Heliopora cœrulea, Blainville. (Samboangan reefs); obtained also at Station 186. Spongodes digitata, n.sp. One specimen (Zebu reefs); obtained at no other locality.

" spicata, n.sp. One specimen (Zebu reefs); obtained at no other locality. Paranephthya capitulifera, n.g., n.sp. One specimen (Samboangan beach); obtained at no other locality. Only species of the genus.
