

In addition, the following are recorded in the note-books :—*Globigerina*, *Hastigerina*, Siphonophoræ, Ctenophoræ (*Beroë*), *Sagitta*, *Tomopteris*, *Cypridina*, Copepods, *Oxycephalus*, Pteropods and larvæ, *Fritillaria*, *Appendicularia*, *Doliolum*, *Salpa*, &c. A tow-net sent down to 200 fathoms contained some Challengeridæ and other Radiolaria, and a tow-net at the trawl brought up some deep-sea Crustacea and Phæodaria.

STATION 297.

The Challenger anchored off the Fort in Cumberland Bay, Juan Fernandez, at 6.30 P.M. on November 13, and sailed at 6 P.M. on November 15 (for description of the island see *Narr. Chall. **Surface Organisms.**—The water in the bay was phosphorescent, and the tow-net procured a great many specimens of *Ceratium (Peridinium) tripos*, along with many Radiolaria, a few *Globigerinæ*, *Appendicularia*, *Salpa*, &c. From the ship many large Crustaceans, belonging to the genus *Palinurus*, were taken by sinking a net with bait, and a great many fishes were taken both from the ship and off Cod Point.

**Station 298** (Sounding 443), Tahiti to Valparaiso (see Chart 38 and Diagram 21). STATION 298.
