2.20 P.M. stopped and sounded in 140 fathoms off Saumarez Island. Put over trawl, which came up at 4.30 P.M. with numerous specimens and a quantity of stones and pebbles. Proceeded for Port Grappler, anchoring there at 5.40 P.M. in 8 fathoms. Pinnace returned with exploring party.
