

ANNELIDA (M'Intosh, Zool. pt. 34).

STATION 311.

Eunoa opalina, n.sp. Several specimens; obtained also at Station 299 (eyeless variety).

Eunice magellanica, n.sp. Several specimens; obtained also at Stations 149 and 308.

OSTRACODA (Brady, Zool. pt. 3).

Cythere dasyderma, n.sp. For distribution see Station 5.

Krithe producta, n.sp. For distribution see Station 70.

Pseudocythere fuegiensis, n.sp. Obtained at no other locality.

MACRURA (Spence Bate, Zool. pt. 52).

Stereomastis suhmi, n.g., n.sp. Nine specimens; obtained also at Station 305.

Campylonotus semistriatus, n.g., n.sp. Many specimens; for distribution see Station 305.

Pasiphæa acutifrons, n.sp. One specimen; obtained also at Station 236.

ANOMURA (Henderson, Zool. pt. 69).

Parapagurus dimorphus (Studer). Several specimens; obtained also at Stations 135, 142, and 145.

Elasmonotus asper, n.sp. Over a dozen specimens; obtained at no other locality.

BRACHYURA (Miers, Zool. pt. 49).

Libinia smithii, n.sp. One specimen; obtained at no other locality.

LAMELLIBRANCHIATA (Smith, Zool. pt. 35).

Saxicava arctica, Linné. For distribution see Station 75.

Lucina lamellata, Smith. Several specimens; obtained at no other locality by the Challenger. Recorded from St. Andrew's Sound and S.W. Patagonia.

Solemya patagonica, n.sp. One specimen; obtained at no other locality.

Modiolarca trapezina (Lamarck). Single valve; obtained also at Stations 145, 149, and 315.

Lima goliath, Sowerby. Single valve; obtained also at Station 236.

Pecten vitreus (Chemnitz). For distribution see Station 204.

GASTEROPODA (Watson, Zool. pt. 42).

Trophon acanthodes, n.sp. Two specimens; obtained also at Station 308.
