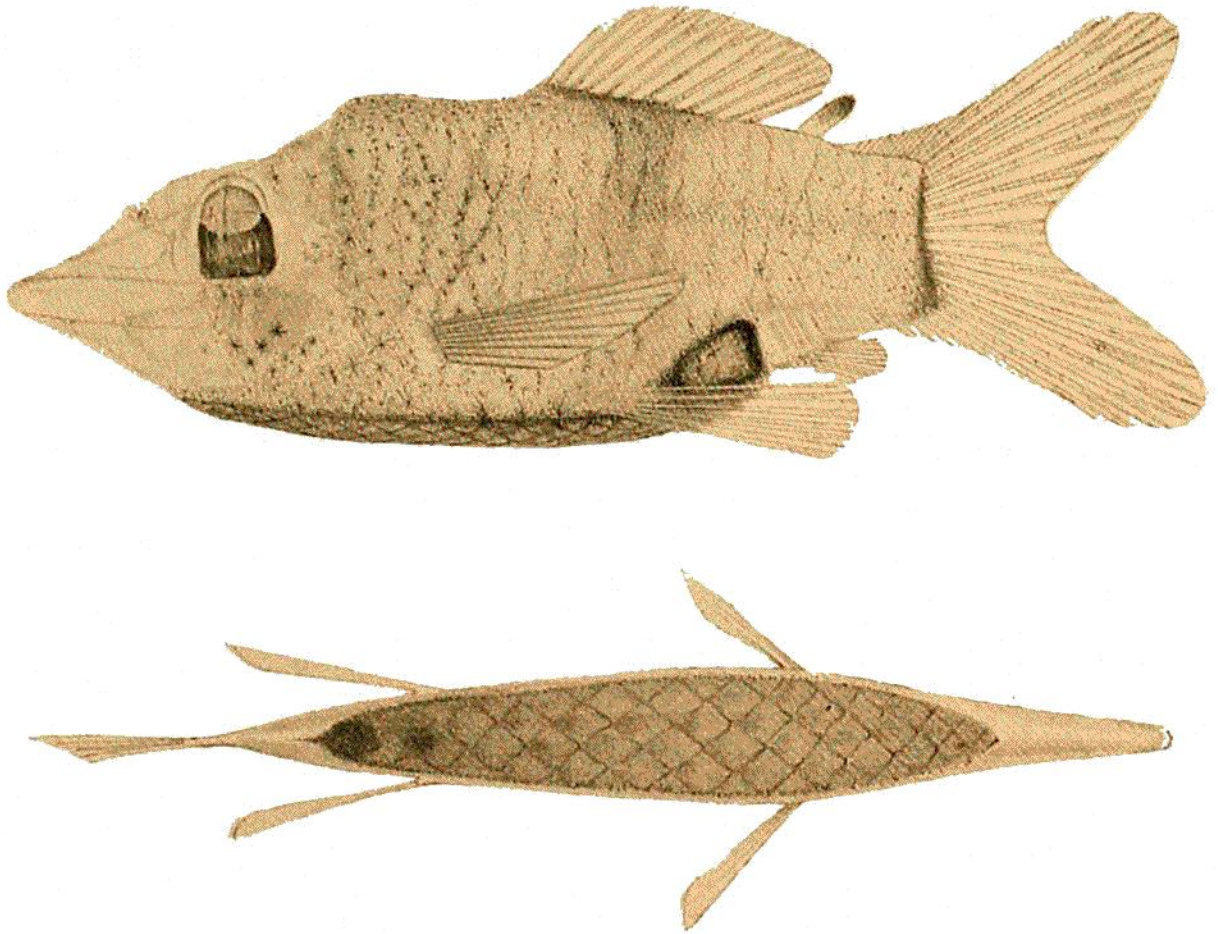

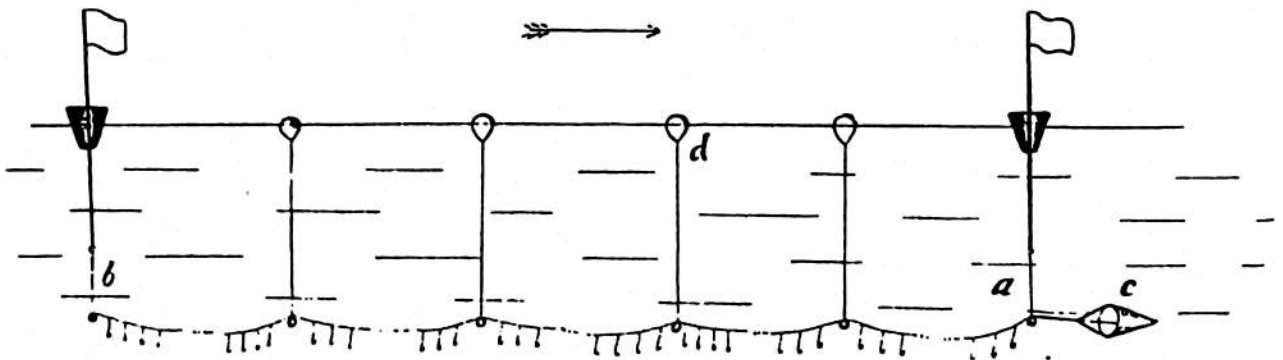


FIG. 74.—FLOATING LONG LINES.
