

Among the metamorphic series there are representatives of crystalline gneisses and schists which could be matched from the Lewisian gneiss

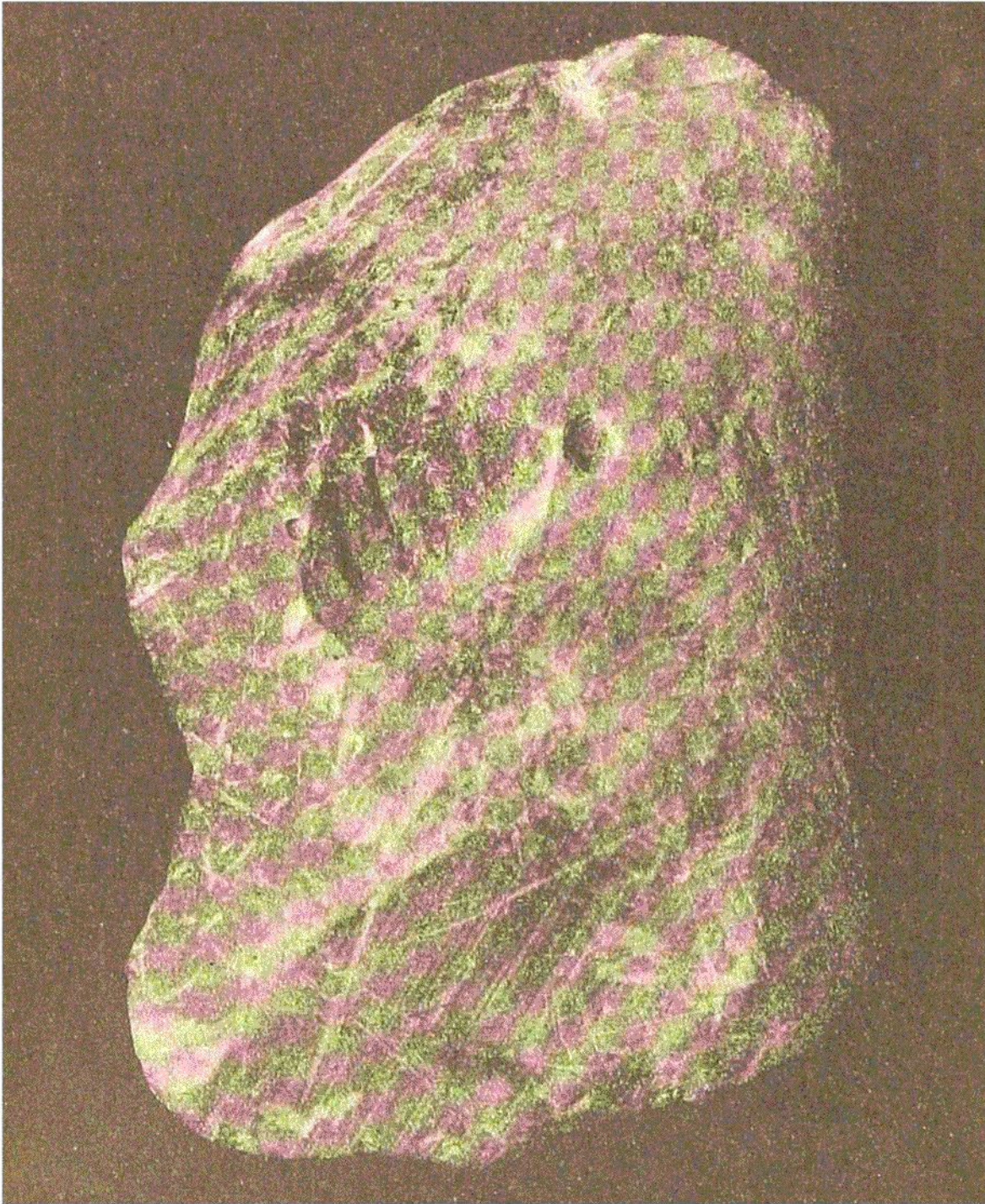


FIG. 145.—GLACIATED STONE FROM "MICHAEL SARS" STATION 95.
