- III. „ „ large pelagic fry, August 1900.

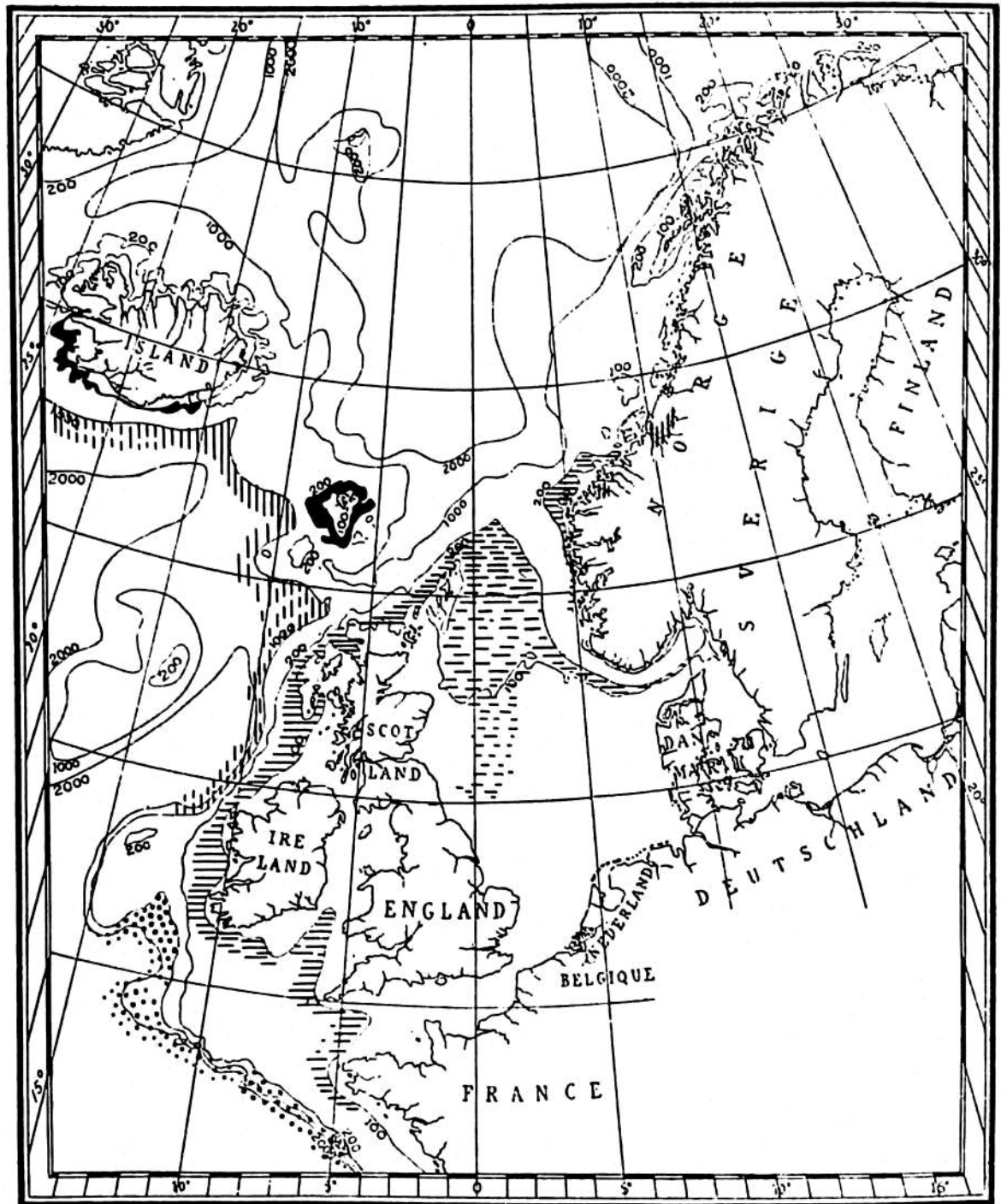


FIG. 522.—SPAWNING REGIONS OF THE THREE SPECIES OF THE GENUS *MOLVA*.
