Figure 1.—Portion of a young plant of *Juniperus bermudiana*, with acicular spreading leaves.

- „ 4.—A branch bearing nearly ripe fruit : all natural size.
- „ 5.—A male inflorescence.
- „ 6, 7.—Fruits, enlarged.
