## VII. THE SOUTH AFRICAN REGION.

It has been allowed to extend from the Cape as far as the Red Sea and to include the Madagascar and Mauritius, as well as the islands of the South Atlantic and Southern Oceans, the Tristan and Prince Edward groups, with the Kerguelen and Heard Islands.
