2. Rossella velata, Wyville Thomson.

A beautiful species of *Rossella* was dredged by Dr. Gwyn Jeffreys in the Atlantic, off the mouth of the Strait of Gibraltar, from a depth of 651 fathoms, and is figured




FIG. 4. - Rossella velata, Wyville Thomson.

and shortly described by Wyville Thomson.¹ Of this form the Challenger Expedition procured no specimen, but I obtained for investigation a specimen dredged by Wyville ¹ Depths of the Sea, pp. 418, 419.
